The Live Event Special Interest Group (LESIG) was originally formed with the purpose of giving feedback regarding player reactions to Live Events. Eventually LESIG went through a period of transition and some members became "liaison officers" for Zion, E Pluribus Neo, Merovingian, Machine, and Cypherite players. These officers interacted with the players as representatives of the Live Event characters from their respective organizations. They also assisted in the planning and implementation of these events.

Liaisons were eventually changed to "contacts' and during the final period they continued to do side stories and were given new tools to help assist them in their roles. LESIG members have also engaged in developing storylines and events for players, such as Scanline, the hovercraft battles, and writing for The Sentinel (an in-game newspaper).

Paula Sleap, a programmer in a small software firm, had an adoring fiancé, loving mother and sister and fond memories of a father who died when she was young. She was a contented bluepill, until compelled to question her reality by aggressive EPN operatives who saw her only as a potential recruit.

The loss she suffered from being Awakened is what drives Dreami to destroy Zion and stamp the red pill out of existence. The cherished life of Paula Sleap continues vividly in Dreami's dreams, painfully raw. It is what motivates her to ensure the peace she knew as a bluepill is not threatened for those who still sleep.



Fuscienne

E Pluribus Neo Liaison

Fuscienne, like many others, was a Zionite before joining up with E Pluribus Neo. The circumstances surrounding her Awakening were a traumatic time for her, but despite it being a time of truce and coming to terms with things, she still found she was searching for something more.

Coming to know others who felt the same as she did, and then having found Michael, Fuscienne worked closely in support of their movement before making the move out of Zion herself. Following a more recent promotion, Fuscienne now carries out her duties as a Liaison Officer aboard the *Neo's Hope*.



Haigen

Cypherite Liaison

Syntax

Not much is known about Haigen before she first appeared among the Cypherites. Excerpts from archive records indicate she was once a Zion operative prior to the Truce. When her crew discovered that she sought to return to the Matrix, their feelings of betrayal led them to a daily ritual of physical torture and mental anguish.

Possessing a fairly impressive network of contacts and skills of a capable assassin, Haigen eagerly performs her duties as a liaison. Her sense of retribution fuels her desire to continue down the path ahead of her.



Harkee

Zion Liaison

Syntax

After the disappearance of her older brother, Harkee was awakened to the truth. Eager to serve Zion, she took up a position as an assistant to the Council. Her affinity for order and organization made her an expert at the job and she served the Council for more than a year. When she learned that a Liaison Officer position needed filling, she jumped at the chance.

Harkee is kind, friendly, and loyal and will always do her best when it comes to protecting and serving Zion and its operatives.



Kompira

Machine Liaison

Vector-Hostile

Noriko Sasaki is dead. Officially killed while reclaiming a barge hijacked by EPN terrorists nearly a month before Kompira surfaced inside the simulation, in truth, Sasaki had been a clandestine machine operative, working in deep cover in the Real since the fall of Morpheus.

Kompira was assigned the duty of liaison to the Machinist cause. After her alleged death on the surface, she was fully reintegrated into the simulation. Outwardly, she is overly positive, however this is believed to be only an effect of a long-term absence from the Matrix. She is, at heart, a cold, devoted cutthroat.



Mnemasyne

E Pluribus Neo Liaison

Before her Awakening, Ms. Gibson was a troubled student who watched as an Agent over-wrote her father. She refused to rationalize or forget what happened, sparking a contempt for authority, and an obsession with retaining her memory and mnematic devices. Hearing about another student named Michael, who "died" after encounter with agents, she sought to find out what happened to him. She found him and was freed, learning about Neo, the Matrix, the machines, and the war.

Operating under the name Mnemasyne, she works closely with Michael using her memory talents to strengthen her body and her cause.

Rejex came from a rich family, but chose to go his own way. He hated high society ways, especially those who abused the poor and weak.

With the help of a childhood friend, Nicholas, Rejex planned a bank robbery during which they executed two security guards. Now wanted for murder by the police, Rejex and Nicholas remained in hiding, Nicholas teaching Rejex the ways of Jurong's gangs. Tragically, Nicholas was killed by a Zion soldier during a firefight between Zion operatives and pursuing Agents. Rejex swore revenge on the Zionite who killed Nicholas. It was his hatred for Zionites that eventually led him to Veil.

Reposco served over ten years with the Zion fleet prior to the Truce. What happened to him and his crew under the Truce is still uncertain as he has lost most of his memory of those events. A group of E Pluribus Neo operatives found him, and after a discussion with Michael on the state of the Truce, Reposco could find no good reason to return to his service under what he saw as a crippled Zion Council.

Reposco's strong sense of justice and deep dedication to the ideals of Neo is where he draws his motivation from to keep doing his duty as a soldier and liaison. He walks his path with zeal, and fights for a future world without fear, borders or controls - a world without the Machines.

Sutola

Cypherite Liaison

Sutola was awakened shortly before the Truce. Shunning service in the Zion military, he only joined a hovercraft crew after the Truce had begun. He worked as a Zion operative until the Cypherite organization surfaced publicly. It was then he realized he'd rather be asleep and defected, leaving behind his murdered crew.

Sutola has little care for genuine combat skills, a factor which is believed to have contributed to his position as a liason. If asked about his aversion to violence, Sutola blithely responds by saying that one who is smarter than his enemy need not resort to animal behavior.



Vogt

Machines Liaison

Syntax

Edmund Vogt is a liaison officer for the Machines organization. Very little is known of his past, but his bluepill life allowed him to be noticed by the Machines. Since his extraction from the System, he displayed an unalterable loyalty to the Machines, but especially to the operatives working for them. By exploiting the human strengths the Machines lack, his goal is to strengthen cooperation between Humans and Machines.

Publicly, he is cold, authoritative, but dedicated. His work is all that counts for him, and nothing could distract him from it.

Soon after Acheronia took the red pill, it dawned on her that she had simply substituted one illusion and system of control (the Matrix) for another one (Zion.) For many months she searched both the Matrix and the real for further answers. She met others like her - people who questioned what their leaders told them - and with planning and luck they stole a hovercraft, renamed it the Scanline, and began a quest to shed light on the lies and illusions they saw by sending out a pirate broadcast into the Matrix.

Unfortunate circumstances killed almost the entire crew, and she found herself the reluctant leader and spokesperson for the Scanline, now with enemies in all corners of the Matrix.

Systematica is an enhanced Sentinel program designed by the Machines to operate within the Matrix. Encoded with a low clearance level, this Machine Liaison officer is deployed in the Vector instance to eradicate terrorists and enemies of the System at large. This program's efficiency was most notably demonstrated with the termination by kill code of EPN Liaison officer Keterina.

Systematica has three major protocols to execute in The Matrix:

- * Disable any enemies of the System in the simulation.
- * Assist Machine operatives in need.
- * Enforce Machine Law and identify potential threats.

exivy

exivy is a descendant of King Louis XIV. The Machines were studying human behavior and social interaction when they decided to force-awaken exivy because of her royal bloodline. The Machines believed that her genetic makeup would instinctively draw operatives to her and she would be able to coerce them into leaving Zion. The Machines, however, did not anticipate exivy's extremely violent resentment.

exivy realized the only way back to her extravagant lifestyle was through the Cypherites. She maintains that even though there is no reinsertion method at this point, she still believes that if anyone can find a way back in, it's Cryptos.

roolith

roolith was awakened at a time way back. He helped Michael [The Kid] with several operations and they became close friends who could trust each other. It looked like roolith had enough potential to work for the EPN organization. As soon as he was introduced to the EPN crusaders, he was under the protective wings of liaison Reposco.

It turned out that Reposco was not respected by the people who followed his command. roolith tried everything to gain their trust and finished his training in an unexpected short time. But as soon as Reposco left his duty, roolith was nothing but bait and he decided to go back desk duty. He was always a lonely, shy person.
